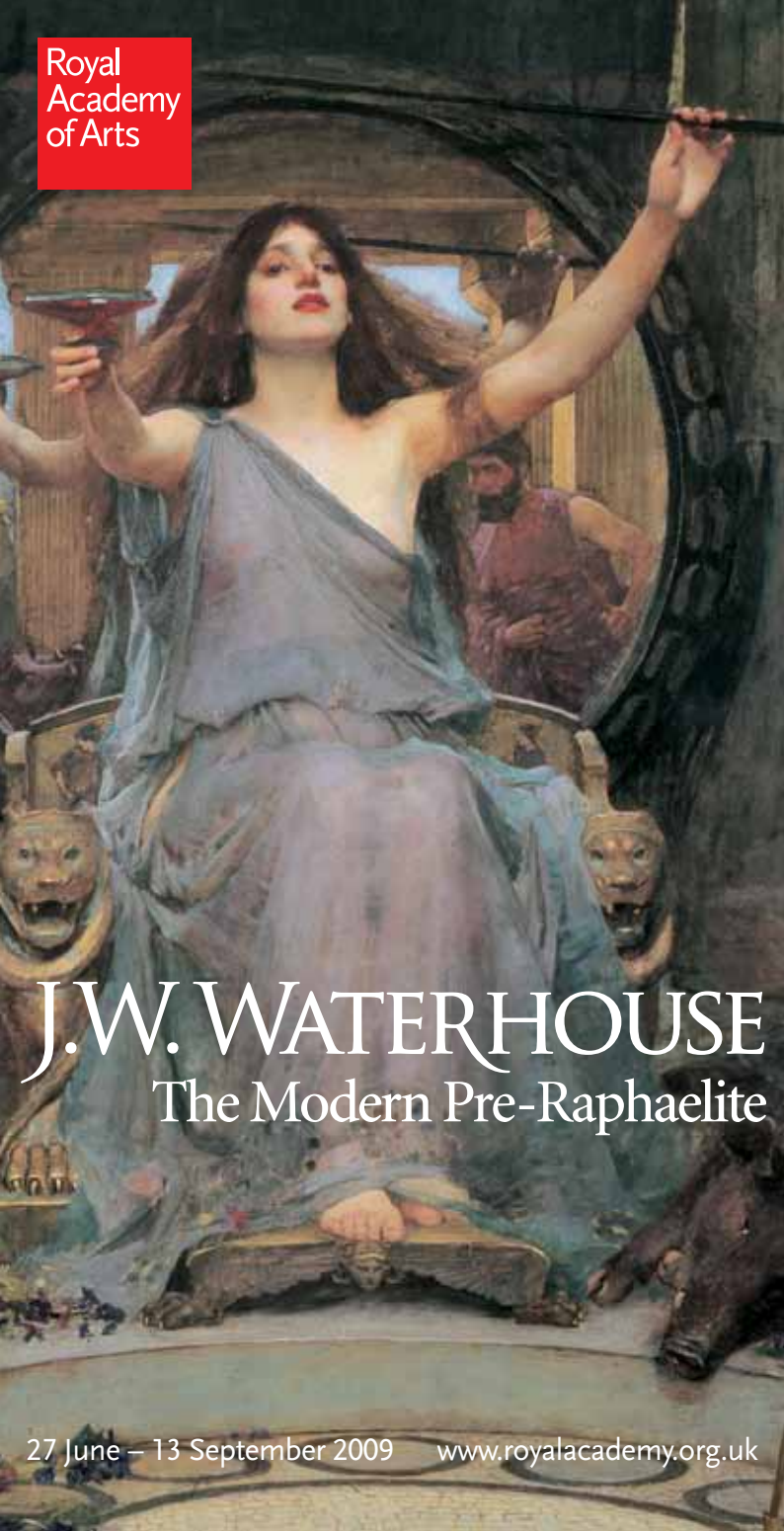

This retrospective, the first major Waterhouse show in the UK since the 1970s, explores how Waterhouse used medieval and classical imagery to engage with contemporary issues such as spiritualism and the 'New Woman'.

Comprising over forty works from both public and private collection, the exhibition includes many of the paintings which made him one of the most successful and critically acclaimed artists of the day. They are accompanied by studies in oil, chalk and pencil, period photographs, sketchbooks and the volumes of Tennyson and Shelley that Waterhouse decorated with sketches.
